

### **Maintenance**

On a regular basis for optimum performance:

- Clean and lubricate moving parts.
  We recommend using SAS Mint General Protectant Spray to lubricate the locks of all our products.
- If the hitch lock is going to fitted for a longer period, a small amount of grease should be put on the locking pin before inserting into the housing.

# SAS FORT 30 GOLD & FORT 35 GOLD Hitchlock Instructions

- Fit the security tow ball in the hitch head. Now, taking the Hitch lock, insert the key into the lock, and rotate until you cannot turn the key any further, the lock should then pop-out.
- Remove the locking pin, by pulling out the extended round silver plated bar, found on the opposite side to the lock holder.
- 3. Fit the red housing to your hitch handle ensure the rear open end of your hitch handle is engaged in the securing compartment found inside at the top of the red housing.
- You can then re-fit the locking pin. It is advisable to pull the rubber gaiter back towards the caravan so that it is clear of the hitch lock, rather than fitting the hitch lock over it
- The locking pin needs to fit snugly. If you have difficulty, then gently shake the fitted hitch lock – this may help the locking bar to seat perfectly.
- Push the lock, ensuring that the lock face is flush with the lock holder.

#### **IMPORTANT**

- 1. Never move or drive vehicle with the hitch lock fitted.
- It is imperative that the hitch lock is fitted correctly for effective protection.
